

## **Dave Hanneman**

Dave Hanneman has more than 37 years of experience in firefighting, emergency management and emergency medical services. He is an Assistant Professor and Program Director for Idaho State University, teaching Homeland Security/Emergency Management and Fire Services Administration.

He started his career in 1984 with the Cole-Collister Fire District in Boise. He transferred to Boise Fire Department in 1988 where he worked for 21 years and achieved the rank of deputy chief. In 2008, he became the fire chief of the city of Chula Vista where he implemented a new paramedic program and developed a fire facility master plan. In October 2014, Dave became the new fire chief of Idaho Falls Fire Department and is now retired. Hanneman holds an A.A.S and B.A.S in fire service technology from Boise State University and a M.Ed. in professional technical education from the University of Idaho. He serves as Chair of the committee on Incident Management Teams with the National Fire Protection Association and contributes to several publications in the Fire Service. Since 2008 he has been designated as chief fire officer from the Center for Public Safety Excellence.
