

# ICS 400

## Advanced Incident Command System

### Course Description

This course provides training and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the ICS. This course expands upon information covered in ICS/IS-100 through ICS 300 courses.

### Objectives

- Explain how major incidents engender special management challenges.
- Describe the circumstances in which an area command is established.
- Describe the circumstances in which multiagency coordination systems are established.

**Primary Core Capability:** Operational Coordination

The target audience for this course is senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity in an area command or multiagency coordination agency.
