COMT

Communications Unit Technician

Course Description

This course is provided through a partnership with the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA).

This class provides introductory and refresher training for the NIMS ICS COMT position. It introduces public safety professionals and support staff to various communications concepts and technologies including interoperable communications solutions, LMR communications, satellite, telephone, data, and computer technologies used in incident response and planned events.

Participants develop the essential core competencies required for performing the duties of the COMT in an all-hazards incident, including responsibilities while operating in a local, regional, or state-level All-Hazards Incident Management Team.

This course is limited to 16 participants.

Audience

This course is designed for state/territory, tribal, urban, and local emergency response professionals and support personnel in all disciplines who have a technical communications background.

Prerequisites

- A public safety communications background with experience in field operations
- A technical communications background
- Awareness of fundamental public safety communications technology
- · Basic knowledge of applicable communications plans
- Required: IS 100, IS 200, IS 700, IS 800
