

# ICS 400

## Advanced Incident Command System

### Course Description

This course provides training and resources to personnel who require advanced knowledge and application of the Incident Command System. The course expands upon information covered in the ICS/IS-100 through ICS/IS-300 courses.

### Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Explain how major incidents engender special management challenges.
- Describe the circumstances in which an area command is established.
- Describe the circumstances in which multiagency coordination systems are established.

### Audience

This course is intended for senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity in an Area Command or Multi-Agency Coordination Entity.

### Prerequisites

**Required:** ICS/IS-100, ICS/IS-200, ICS/IS-300, ICS/IS-700, ICS/IS-800
