Procurement Under Grants

Course Description

This one and a half day training offers students an understanding of the federal standards found at 2 C.F.R. §§ 200.317-327 that govern the procurement of goods and services under a federal award. The course will help recipients and sub-recipients of FEMA awards understand the rules that apply to state and non-state entities, the approved methods of procurement and requirements for each type, and common risk areas of non-compliance that could lead to ineligible contract costs.

Note: All students must bring a laptop to class

Course Objectives:

- Evaluate if a recipient or subrecipient's actions are restrictive of competition;
- Assess an entity's procurement need to determine the appropriate method of procurement
- Review a procurement contract and identify areas of non-compliance with the federal regulations.
