

Idaho Mitigation Dashboard HUB

Introduction


The Mitigation Dashboard HUB was created to assist jurisdictions with implementing local mitigation plans. Each Tribe and county have a hazard mitigation plan with projects or actions to reduce risk. The Mitigation Dashboard displays actions from each jurisdiction's hazard mitigation plans prior to 2020. The actions may be edited, prioritized, and new actions created. Generate and submit a pre-application directly from each action. Planning teams may use the dashboard for education, training, and plan maintenance. Please keep your actions current with the latest approved plan.

Use instructions:

New users will need to register at <u>IOEM Mitigation Registration (arcgis.com</u>). Administrators will create your account and email a temporary password which will be good for 14 days. Log into the dashboard <u>https://idahohub.maps.arcgis.com</u>.

All actions are displayed on the state map for viewing and are color coded by status. You may click on any icon to view action details. The toolbar has options available at the navigation lines, and sorting by jurisdiction and status. To view actions in a specific location, click magnifying glass on the map toolbar and enter the address in the search field. Various base maps are available on the map toolbar. Tabs at the bottom of the map provide quick access for edits and mitigation information. The left sidebar contains instructions and resources and conveniently hides from view by clicking on the arrow. Mitigation actions are listed on the left of the screen and pre-applications on the right. Choosing Submit saves edits to actions and pre-applications. If you are not authorized for the selected county, you will receive an error message. Attachments are only available when creating a pre-application. When editing a pre-application, additional attachments must be emailed to IOEM Mitigation, 2018MitigationGrants@imd.idaho.gov. You may print a pre-application to pdf and save it to your computer, then copy sections to a grant application when a funding opportunity is announced. The Mitigation Section, will review your pre-application and reply to the contacts provided. The pre-applications help jurisdictions have shelf-ready projects.

Add new mitigation actions from updated All Hazard Mitigation Plans and approved by planning teams by choosing the far-right dropdown, click Create a New Project, complete the form, and then save.
