The National Emergency Management Basic Academy L0146: Homeland Security Exercise & Evaluation Program (HSEEP)

Course Description

This FEMA course is part of a Career Development Program in which participants learn an established set of emergency management competencies through a progressive training and education system that includes the entry-level National Emergency Management Basic Academy. The L0146 is an intermediate-level course designed to provide a set of guiding principles, standardized methodology, available resources and practical skill development, which will assist in developing an HSEEP consistent exercise program. This course describes a common approach to exercise program management, design and development, conduct, evaluation, and improvement planning.

Course Objectives

Understand the role of HSEEP in National Preparedness, and how HSEEP exercise principles and methodology support efforts across the whole community to improve our national capacity to build, sustain, and deliver core capabilities.

Audience

This course is intended for newly appointed emergency managers from federal, state, local, tribal, and territorial emergency management agencies and prospective professionals transferring from other disciplines to emergency management.
