

G-0191: Emergency Operations Center/ Incident Command System Interface

The purpose of this course is to enable the students to develop an effective interface between the Incident Command/Unified Command and the Emergency Operations Center by applying National Incident Management System principles.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Explain potential ICS/EOC interface challenges
- Explain key NIMS concepts, command and coordination systems, and structures
- Analyze given scenarios to determine commonalities and potential interface issues between ICS and EOCs
- Explain the respective roles and interconnectivity of the NIMS command and coordination systems
- Contrast the typical role and functions of the IC and the EOC during emergency operations
- Analyze given scenarios to apply ICS/EOC interface concepts
