 - c. PM Report:
 - i. Call handling equipment site visits will occur October 28-30th for the high priority sites that required a refresh prior to January 1. Nampa and Owyhee Co will have site surveys done since they are in close proximity. A project planning team will be meeting on Oct 30th to further discuss the path ahead.
 - ii. The Motrola ESINet team will be conducting site surveys on Nov 10-14 for the Hostagencies: Post Falls, Ada/Kootenai, SIRCOMM/Elmore, and Bannock
 - iii. The IDAPA 15.06.01 will need legislative approval to finalize the temporary changes approved by the IPSCC. The summary of these changes are as follows: allowance for 5-year contracts, Commission ability to amend awards, Commission ability to consider adjusting grant application period, agency acknowledgement of GIS data maintenance and submission, and reduction in application data requirements from agencies.

 - 2. I think the changes worked as intended this cycle and enabled us to secure NGCS moving forward. I don't have any additions/changes
 - iv. IRON: this contract is still in work and may become a concern if not submitted before mid Nov. I am in contact with IRON and brief if there are problems.
