CYBER BRIEF Chris Volmer	State cybersecurity initiatives overview. Main goal is to protect Idaho's critical infrastructure. Using FY2022-FY2025 grant funds across 4 years, projected to expend all \$12.5m by 2028. This includes many state agencies as well as jurisdictions, counties, cities, tribes, etc. to meet the needs of everyone monitored/approved by FEMA.  Another taskforce recommendation was to build a 5 year defense strategy. Drafting top 5 priorities to enact subcommittees to continue the work.	Takeaway: continue building these resources and relationships with this commission to work on these projects and keep the mission going. #### **OPEN FORUM**

Copstead - Dave Taylor mentioned in chat that we need to send ranked nominations to the governor. Conversation clarified nomination ranking is for nominations of committee members, not for Chairman.

Gonzalez – Are there plans for Brad Richy's retirement/awards? Discussion to bring in the Governor/TAG to present him with an award. Mildiv plans to do a ceremony in May, so may lump into that to avoid multiple events.

Gonzalez – Do any of the DOGE funding freezes impact anything on our end? Most concerns are with IOEM grant funds freezing. The manual review may take 30 days or longer. However, not a concern for the committee operations itself.

Creech – Discussion of HB14 passed and signed into law – requires all state agencies to go through and analyze sections of state law that impact them and submit a report by Sept 1 to scrub laws needing updated/removed.

Pam Bond – GIS update. Checking for anomalies by end of 2026, will be going for another RFP to get that ready. Also working on MOU for counties on grant fee to comply with GIS standards.
