

Idaho Office of Emergency Management Federal Fiscal Year 2022 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program Local Application/Consent Agreement

This document serves as an agreement for local entities to receive cybersecurity services including assessments, training, governance, and policy support. Provided by the Idaho Office of Emergency Management (IOEM) as part of the FY22 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program, these services are meant to increase cybersecurity resilience and preparedness. Due to the amount of funds available for "pass through" to local entities (\$1,680,440) being insufficient to meaningfully address cybersecurity issues, IOEM intends to provide services in lieu of funding to maximize impact. Services will primarily be provided by regionally based Cybersecurity Field Officers for inperson support among participating entities. Participating organizations must agree to complete the Nationwide Cybersecurity Review (NCSR) with an IOEM addendum annually to inform what services need to be addressed in future years' funding.

Idaho's FY22 State and Local Grant Program (award EMW-2022-CY-00057) is authorized by Section 2220A(n)(2) of the Homeland Security Act of 2022, Pub.L. No.107-296 as amended by 6 U.S.C. § 665g(n)(2). This is a non-research grant guided by Idaho's State and Local Cybersecurity Plan created by a committee of local, state and federal partners focused on a whole of state approach to enhancing Idaho's cybersecurity posture.

IOEM's planned activities and estimated costs to be distributed through services across all participating entities are: (no match is required from local entities)

\$900,000 for Risk Assessment (NCSR) and Gap Management

\$450,000 for Cybersecurity Governance and Planning

\$330,440 for Cybersecurity Training

Assistance will begin with a Self-Assessment and Gap Analysis. Services will be customized as each participating entity's cybersecurity needs will vary.
