


## How to Determine if a Vendor is Debarred or Suspended

Idaho Office of Emergency Management (IOEM) subgrantees must comply with 2 CFR §200.214 as it relates to contracting with vendors that have been debarred or suspended. As a subgrantee of a federal grant through IOEM, it is your responsibility to ensure that the vendors you contract with have not been debarred or suspended. Follow the instructions below to check your prospective vendors.

- Go to [www.sam.gov](http://www.sam.gov)
- For this task you do not need to enter your username or password
- You will see a screen that looks like this.



As an illustration to familiarize you with this process, we'll look at two different vendors, one with no exclusions for debarments or suspension and one that does have exclusions for funding under federal grants. We'll start with Ford Motor Company, who we do not expect to be debarred or suspended. On the opening screen of sam.gov click on the "Entity Information" label.

This will provide a screen that tells us that no matches were found for exclusions against Ford Motor Company for debarment or suspension. That is what we expected. It's a good idea to take a screen shot of this screen (noting the date) to show that at the time you contracted this entity there were no exclusions.




