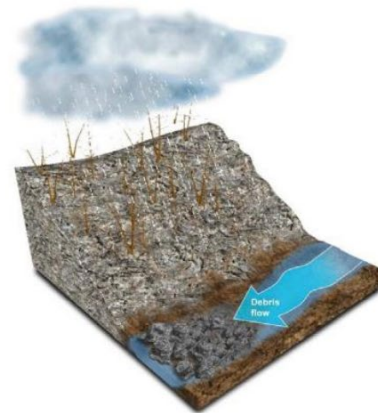
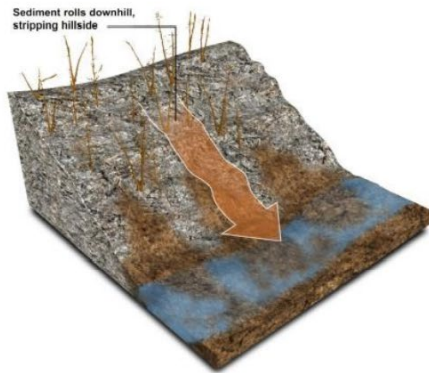

# Increased risk

- ▶ Following a wildfire, burned soil can chemically change and become water repellent which can lead to flash floods and mudflow.
- ▶ Post-fire flooding can quickly destroy roads, bridges and buildings.





# Hazard Mitigation Grant Program

- ▶ Eligible subapplicants: Tribes, local governments/communities, private non-profits, state agencies
- ▶ Natural hazards risk reduction
- ▶ HMGP funding = 15% of disaster federal share
- ▶ 5% Management Costs
- ▶ Competitive within Nez Perce County and Tribe
- ▶ Must have adopted an approved mitigation plan
- ▶ Funding Initiatives:
  - 5% non-BCA (for example warning sirens)
  - 7% Planning
- ▶ Cost shares
  - 75% Federal Funding
  - 25% Non-Federal Funding



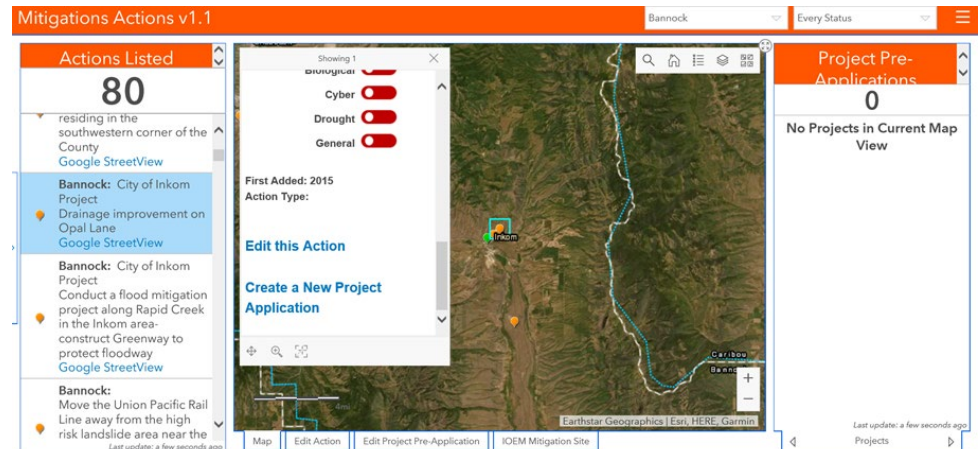
# HMGP Deadlines

- ▶ Submit Pre-application online by **September 24, 2021**
- ▶ Application Development Training **October 13, 2021**
- ▶ Submit Complete Project Applications by: **February 28, 2022**
- ▶ Projects reviewed and Recommendation made to IOEM Director by: **March 24, 2021**
- ▶ Selected Applications submitted to FEMA Region X for funding by: **March 31, 2022**

Grant opens statewide if all funds not requested by effected jurisdictions by: **October 24, 2021**

- Submit by 9/24/21

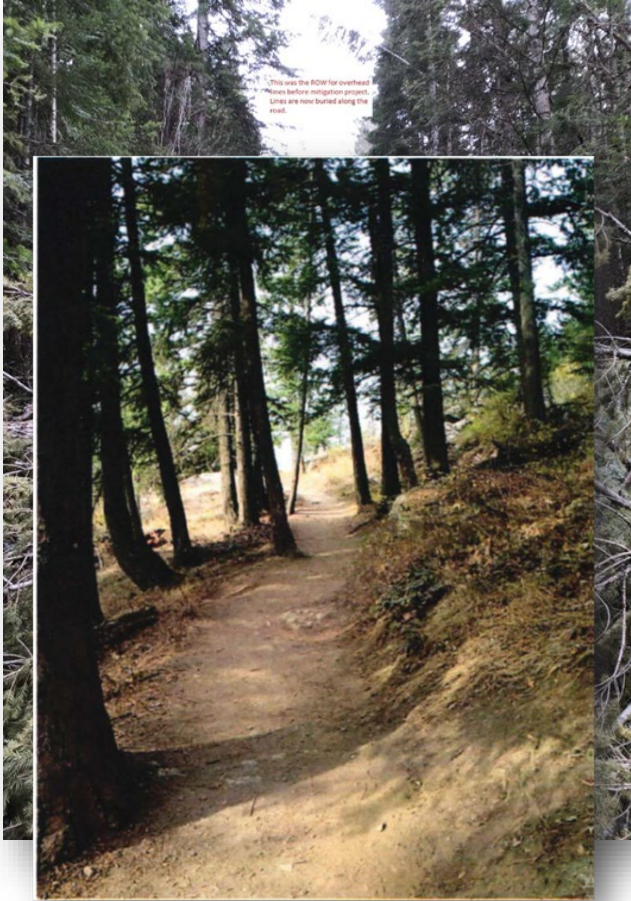




# Eligible Mitigation Projects

- ▶ Update Hazard Mitigation Plans
- ▶ Adopt and enforce building codes and develop standards
- ▶ Bury overhead power lines
- ▶ Elevating roads or upsizing bridges and culverts
- ▶ Stormwater drainage improvements
- ▶ Wildfire fuel reduction within 2 miles of structures
- ▶ Outreach activities
