Intermediate Incident Command System

Course Description

This course provides training and resources for personnel who required advanced knowledge and application of the ICS. The course expands upon information covered in the ICS/IS-100 and ICS/IS-200 courses.

Objectives

- Describe how the NIMS command and management component supports the management of expanding incidents.
- Describe the incident/event management process for supervisors and expanding incidents as prescribed by the Incident Command System.
- Implement the incident management process in a simulated Type 3 incident.
- Develop an Incident Action Plan for a simulated incident.

Primary Core Capability: Planning

Audience

This course is intended for individuals and field (ICS) personnel who may be assigned supervisory roles during Type 1, 2, and 3 incidents.

NOTE: During a Type 3 incident, some or all of the command and general staff positions may be activated, as well as division or group supervisor and/or unit leader positions. These incidents may extend into multiple operational periods.

Prerequisites

Required: ICS/IS-100, ICS/IS-200, ICS/IS-700, ICS/IS-800
