Good Afternoon,

Thanks for carving out some time to meet with us to get the radio upgrade for ADA county kicked off. Noted below are the notes taken from the meeting and some action items.

ADA County Attendees: Karl Rudorf, Stephaine Johnson, Natasha Koff, Mark Camin (ISP), Jeremey (ISP), Robert Bachman (Intermountain Communications), **MSI Attendees:** Dean Kroeger, Keith Cook, Nancy Copler, Monty Dana, Josh Horwath, Steven Slusser, Richard Creet, Tim Herlihy

Notes from the kickoff meeting noted below.

- Reviewed the team members who will be working on the upgrade from a UO engineering and Field perspective.
- Discussed the console upgrade approach whereas the shops will deploy the new and upgrade the existing
 certified consoles. MSI will pre-configure the new computers in our Phoenix office and ship them to shops for
 deployments. The co-located dispatch site has a backup site that can be used to upgrade the co-located site
 while agents are at the backup center.
- We discussed the CAD system and will set up some communications with Center Square to make sure they are compatible with the new radio release and if support will be needed during the course of the upgrade.
- Discussed upgrading the IMW remotely or onsite. There are (2) IMWs at the core site and another IMW remote. Tim will work with Shahid on schedule and plan to upgrade all.
- The Nice upgrade for ISP will be onsite as there is equipment to be refreshed. Additionally the ADA County is currently scheduled to be upgraded remotely as it is software only upgrade.
- Access to the site will be granted and 6 badges were requested for the MSI resources. CJIS certification will be investigated and completed as necessary.
- We discussed the ISP FW and the hot spare. MSI will investigate if the hardware is current or needs to be refreshed as well.
- The KVL 5000s will be upgraded and the KVL 4000s have not had any changes for some time and will not be upgraded at this time.
- We chatted about the process for the post upgrade and how MSI can improve on the upgrade experience.
 Once the upgrade is complete we will review all the outstanding items including any open support cases that may or may not have an impact on the system. MSI will work to get all open items resolved in a timely manner by working with support and the field/shops. MSI will provide a focal point to resolve all the outstanding punchlist items.
- Biweekly calls will be set up to discuss the upgrade and open it up for general discussion.


