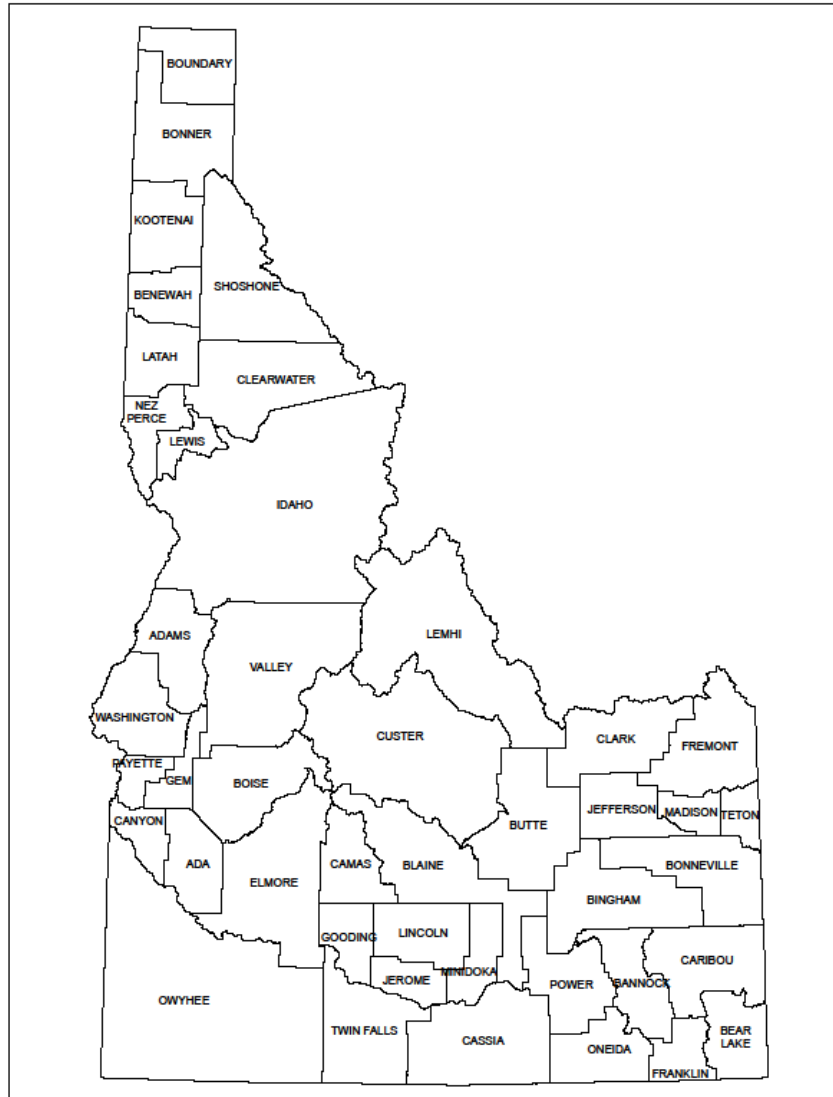

If you are a state, local, tribal, taxing entity, or a private non-profit providing critical or essential services you may be eligible for FEMA Public Assistance. Public Assistance is a reimbursement grant program for extraordinary eligible expenses associated with COVID-19 response and recovery activities.

The IOEM Recovery Team, in partnership with FEMA, is ready to help your organization navigate the process to apply for Public Assistance. The following documents provide information, guidance and additional resources for your organization.



- Small Project - Up to \$131,100
 - Versions Can be Created
- Large Project - More than \$131,100
